## Safe Dismissal Procedures

### Late Bus

- Select the site where your child will be dropped off and enter it on the enrollment form.
- Arrive 10 minutes before the scheduled time and approach the bus to meet the student(s).

### **Identification is required.**

- For a child to be dropped off, a parent or other designee must be waiting at the stop.
- Contact the school and send a note if there are any changes in dismissal plans.
- The North Bus will arrive at stops 15 minutes early on Fridays.

### Sliding Scale Fees

In order to help sustain this valuable program, trimester fees are charged for the afterschool clubs. It is a requirement of our 21st CCLC grant that we provide a sliding scale fee system for our families.

- Fees are based on the free/reduced school lunch program and are charged per club for the entire trimester.
- Fees will not be adjusted in the event of an absence or cancellation.
